

By purchasing a standard in ground pool closing package, you acknowledge that you have read, understand, and agree to the terms of the Pool Opening Agreement Below.

Sun Pools 2018 Pool Closing Service Agreement

Included with each opening are the following:

- Sun Pools will remove ladders and hand rails.
- Sun Pools will winterize the filter system, and heating system.
- Sun Pools will blow the main drain, skimmer, and return lines.
- Sun Pools will install customers' winterizing plugs.
- Sun Pools will add antifreeze to the lines and winterizer into the pool water.
- Sun Pools will install customers' cover.

Customer Responsibilities:

- Customer should have pool water chemically balanced.
- Customer should vacuum the pool and have to clear of any debris.
- Customer to supply, winter plugs and winter cover.
- **Any of the above items that are not available at time of closing, winter plugs, plate or ice compensator, Sun Pools will charge your invoice accordingly.**

Special Notes regarding opening package pricing:

The cost defined herein for all pool opening and closing related services are subject to change at the sole discretion of Sun Pools in the event the nature of the service falls outside of what is defined herein. For swimming pools that are larger in size, have multiple pumps/filters systems, have large water features, complex spa features or require additional manpower and/or additional on-site time outside of what Sun Pools normally includes with a standard pool opening or closing service, Sun Pools reserves the right to adjust the price based on current service and labor rates. A typical opening or closing service is generally defined as a person that can perform an opening or closing service in 60 minutes or less of on-site time. The standard swimming pool is generally constructed with a single pump and filter. If you feel that the nature of your swimming pool may create additional charges to be applied, please contact Sun Pools Service Department to discuss further.
